

**Twenty nine****PRESCOT-CLOCK AND WATCH MUSEUM.**

A small shopping town (like Eccles!) with an attractive area round the pink sandstone church

Take the Liverpool train from Eccles Station and alight at Huyton station. Outside the front of the station go right down the steps to the other platform. Board a Wigan train and alight at Prescott

Outside the station door go right and cross the main road. Take the street up the side of 'The Dog House' and cross the circle towards the new shopping centre. *Shades of West One?*

Go between the centre shops then head straight up the street towards The Crown Hotel, 1876. *It has a rather grand sign.* Continue up past this pub and past a church (now converted to flats) on the right.

Now turn left along Eccleston Street (*the shopping street*) towards the church. At the end of this street cross the road. Go between Prescott Parish church and The Deane's House. *Attractive old houses on this alley.*

Turn right at the Roman Catholic Church of 'Our Lady Immaculate and St Joseph'. When this alley meets the street turn right back towards Deane's House.

You will see Prescott museum to the left. *It is open Tuesday – Saturday 10.00-13.00 and 14.00 to 17.00, Sunday 14.00-17.00. Admissions free.*

Coming out of the museum turn left down through bus station and left onto Eccleston Road to retrace your steps to the railway station and cross to the Liverpool platform.

Board a Liverpool train and alight at Huyton. Cross under the platforms and board a Manchester train back to Eccles.
