

**Eight        MOSSLEY - GREENFIELD via CANAL.**

A lovely country walk along the Huddersfield Canal. This walk could be done as a continuation of the preceding one.

Take the train to Manchester or Stalybridge and change onto a Huddersfield stopping train.

Alight at Mossley station.

*Notice the fine buildings in this little town.*

Outside the station almost opposite you is Mill Street. Go down this steep street and cross the River Bridge and then the Canal Bridge.

At end of the Canal Bridge U-turn right down a narrow path between the bridge and a works yard.

At the canal side turn right and follow the canal bank.

At bridge 88 cross the canal, go right and continue on the other side.

At Roaches Lock there is a public house called appropriately enough Roaches Lock!

At bridge 86 you need to cross the canal and continue on the opposite side.  
*If you look behind you at this bridge you will see The Tollemache Arms (Robinson's beers).*

At bridge 82 I hope that you enjoy the panorama that opens up in front of you.

Continue until bridge 80 where you go up the steps on the right hand side. At the top of the steps turn left and go uphill.

At the main road junction go right towards Oldham and Greenfield Station is on your left.

*Across the Road from the station is The Railway public house (CAMRA national good beer guide and evening entertainment).*
